

PROFESSIONAL PEELS

Profession peelings

Chemical peels can be defined as an accelerated form of exfoliation induced by a chemical agent.

It activates different types of changes in the skin, depending on the depth of the peel.

Cosmo Peel Cream:

Mask Peel



Presentation

- 50ml pot – 25 applications.
- Clay-based mask for professional peel treatment.

- Glycolic acid 30%
- pH 2.5

Indications

Greasy, acne-prone skin, visible pores, excess sebum, dermatological facial cleansing.

Precautions

Not for use during pregnancy.

Avoid exposure to UV light for at least 48 hours after treatment.

Instructions for use

1. Cleanse the face using **Foamer 15**, rinse and dry.
Do not use an alcohol or acetone-based toner.
2. Apply 2ml of **Mask Peel** evenly to the skin using a spatula or with gloved fingers.
3. Leave for 2 minutes to take effect.
4. Rinse abundantly with water.
5. When the skin is dry, apply **Hyal Ceutic** to calm and repair the skin after the peel treatment.

Mask Peel may be applied up to 4 times in total at 2-week intervals.



Follow-up

Apply **Hyal Ceutic** every day for at least one month after the peel to repair and hydrate the skin.

We recommend combining the peel with a well tailored personal care treatment at home: use **Mask 15** once to twice per week.

Depigmenting medium peel

3. Leave for a maximum of 1 minute as a keratolytic peel to enhance the effects of **Spot Peel**'s active ingredients.
4. Rinse and dry.
5. Apply 6 pump doses of **Spot Peel** on the entire face, until complete penetration. Add 1-2 pump doses of **Spot Peel** on the most pigmented areas and massage thoroughly until it penetrates fully into the skin.
6. Leave to take effect: the patient may return home still wearing this invisible mask and rinse it off with water after a maximum of 8 hours.
7. Apply **K Ceutic** as often as necessary in the 72 hours after the peeling for its repair and sun protection properties. From the 4th day, the patient must apply **Spot Cream** every night for one month as part of the **Spot Peel** protocol. We also recommend continuing the application of **K Ceutic** in the morning to optimize the results.

Spot Peel may be applied again after 1 month if the results are not satisfactory or in the event of severe melasma.



Follow-up

To maintain the results, **Spot Cream** should gradually be replaced by **Yellow Cream** the second month after the **Spot Peel** treatment.

We recommend combining the peel with a well-tailored personal care treatment at home: to prepare the skin 15 days before the peel, apply **C25 Cream** in the morning and **Light Ceutic** at night.

Milk Peel



Presentation

- 60ml bottle – 25 applications.
- Milky-textured peel for easy application and high tolerance.

- Glycolic acid 50%, lactic acid 10% and salicylic acid
- pH 1.7

Indications

Dull complexion, wrinkles, epidermal stimulation, smoothing effect for softer skin.

Cosmetic active ingredients penetration enhancer.

Precautions

Not for use during pregnancy.

Avoid exposure to UV light for at least 1 week after treatment.

Instructions for use

1. Cleanse the face using **Foamer 15**, rinse and dry.
Do not use an alcohol or acetone-based toner.
2. Apply 2ml of **Milk Peel** with the brush to the face and neck.
3. Leave for 1 to 2 minutes. For thick skin, massage the **Milk Peel** into the skin. The skin will turn slightly pink.
4. Rinse abundantly with water.
5. When the skin is dry, apply **Hyal Ceutic** to calm and repair the skin after the peel treatment.

Milk Peel may be used up to 4 times in total at 2-week intervals.

Body peel treatment requires a specific protocol: contact us for further advice.

Follow-up

Apply **Hyal Ceutic** as often as possible after the peel to repair and nourish the skin.



We recommend combining the peel with a well tailored personal care treatment at home: 15 days before the first peel and each time in between 2 treatments when the skin is back to normal. Use **C25 Cream** in the morning and **Turn Over** at night.

Cosmo Peel



Kits available: TCA 12%, 15%, 18% and 20%

Presentation

- One 20 ml bottle of TCA based mixtures for a total of 12 applications.
- Cosmo Peel Cream 30 ml: homogenizing cream for maximum comfort and optimized results, 12 applications.

- Cosmo Peel Cream: Lactic acid, salicylic acid, citric acid, retinyl palmitate, ascorbic acid, selenomethionine, alpha tocopherol acetate
- Cosmo Peel Cream: pH 3.5

Indications

Aging skin, dark spots and wrinkles, smoker's complexion, stretch marks and acne scars.

Precautions

Not for use during pregnancy.

Avoid exposure to UV light for at least 1 month after the final treatment.

Use SPF 50 in case of sun exposure.

Do not wear perfume before and after the treatment.

Do not use a TCA higher than 15% for skin phototypes above 4.

Spot Peel



Presentation

- Spot Peel 15ml pump bottle – 5 applications.
 - Spot Cream 30ml pump bottle – depigmentation cream, 1 to 2 months application for one patient.
- Spot Peel and Spot Cream: Mandelic acid, idebenone, emblica, retinol and salicylic acid
- Spot Peel: pH 2.9

Indications

Pigmentation spots, pregnancy dark spots, melasma, post-inflammatory pigmentation.
All phototypes.

Precautions

Not for use on patients using Vitamin A Acid.

Not for use during pregnancy.

Avoid exposure to UV light for at least 1 month after treatment.

Use a broad spectrum high SPF sunscreen in the morning to guarantee a good UV protection and to avoid the reappearance of pigmentation spots.

Instructions for use

1. Cleanse the face using **Foamer 15**, rinse and dry.
Do not use an alcohol or acetone-based toner.
2. Apply 2ml of **Milk Peel** with the brush to the face and neck.

Depigmenting medium peel

3. Leave for a maximum of 1 minute as a keratolytic peel to enhance the effects of **Spot Peels** active ingredients.
